Louis Althea Beach Hotel condemns all forms of child exploitation and is against child labour. The prohibition of child labour is a fundamental principle in all partnerships between our hotels, suppliers, and service providers.

Louis Group is committed to the implementation of laws for the protection of minors and to respect the rights of children. This commitment extends to the children of customers, and we are committed to protecting them from all forms of exploitation including sexual exploitation.

Louis Hotels ensures that all employees are trained in children's rights, in the recognition of cases of child abuse and in the application of the appropriate procedure. All suspicious activities will be reported to the relevant local authorities, whether from customers or employees.

In case you suspect a sexual or any other abuse you report it immediately to the coordinator Mr. Charalambos Ioannou, who must report it to the local authorities.

The hotel intends to protect children from any form of abuse, following the six steps of the **CODE** of conduct of EPCAT (End Child Prostitution, Pornography & Trafficking for sexual purposes) for the safety of children against sexual abuse in tourism. The Code (short for "The Code of Conduct for the Protection of Children from Sexual Exploitation in Travel and Tourism") is an industry-driven responsible tourism initiative with a mission to provide awareness, tools and support to the tourism industry in order to prevent the sexual exploitation of children.
